A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BUILDING COMMITTEE, TOGETHER WITH MEMBERS OF THE LIBRARY BOARD OF DIRECTORS, WAS HELD ON OCTOBER 6, 1967, AT 4:30 P.M. IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE MAIN LIBRARY. THOSE PRESENT WERE: MR. FREYFOGLE, MR. OLSEN, MR. SAPPINGTON, MR. SCHUERMAN, MR. DUMAS, MISS SCHWEGMAN, AND MR. SCHMELZER AND MR. PORTER, CONSULTANTS FOR INTERIOR PLANNING AND DESIGN SERVICES OF NEW YORK CITY. A BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF MR. SCHMELZER'S REMARKS FOLLOWS:

I WOULD BE SAFE IN SAYING THAT IF WE LIVED A LITTLE BIT WITH THE SITUATION AND PICKED UP INFORMATION ABOUT THE COMMUNITY AND THEN WHEN WE HAVE THE INFORMATION AND KNOW WHAT YOU HAVE AND WANT, WE COULD WORK OUT THE HOUSING -- 65,000 SQUARE FEET OF HOUSING. WE COULD SEE SCHEMATICALLY HOW WE WOULD WORK OUT WHAT KIND OF A LIBRARY AND WHAT KIND OF SERVICES WOULD BE ADVISABLE -- DEPARTMENTAL RELATIONSHIPS AND LIMITATIONS OF THE SITE AREA -- BUILT IN SUCH A WAY THAT WE COULD EXPAND AT A LATER TIME.

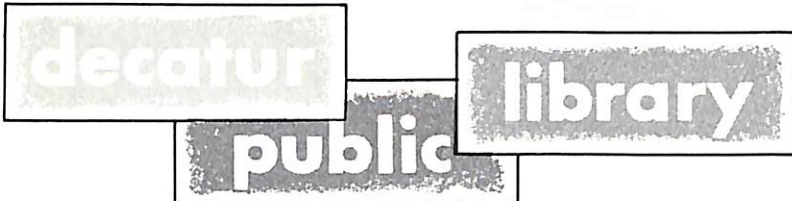
IT WOULD BE A HINDRANCE IF THERE WERE NO SITE, BUT ACTUALLY YOU HAVE TWO SITES UNDER CONSIDERATION SO WE ARE NOT LEFT IN A WIDE OPEN AREA. THE PROGRAM COULD BE WRITTEN WITHOUT AN EXACT SITE AND THEN UPON THE SELECTION OF A SITE, WE WOULD UNDERTAKE TO REVISE THE PLANS INSOFAR AS NECESSARY. THIS WOULD BE PART OF OUR ASSIGNMENT. THE BASICS WOULD REMAIN THE SAME BUT THE SCHEMATICS WOULD BE DIFFERENT. WE WOULD BE CONCERNED WITH ALL THE SERVICES IN THE CITY IF THIS IS THE ASSIGNMENT YOU GIVE US.

THE LIBRARY THAT WOULD COME CLOSEST TO THIS ONE WOULD BE THE QUEENS BOROUGH LIBRARY IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK. THIS IS A UNIQUE LIBRARY. IT HAS VIRTUALLY ALL SERVICES ON ONE FLOOR. MOST OF OUR WORK HAS BEEN IN THE EAST AND IN THE LONG ISLAND AREA. WE HAVE DONE A DOZEN OR 14 LIBRARIES IN THE PAST 6 OR 7 YEARS.

I BASED OUR FEE ON 1% OF A MILLION AND A HALF DOLLARS OR TWO MILLION (I USED THE LOWER FIGURE). THAT IS HOW I BASED THE FEE. HOWEVER, A FLAT FEE ITEMIZING EVERYTHING COULD BE WORKED OUT RATHER THAN THE PERCENTAGE ARRANGEMENT. WE WILL SEND YOU A ROUGH DRAFT OF SUCH A PROGRAM WITHIN THE NEXT WEEK OR SO.

OUR WORK WOULD INCLUDE ALL THE INTERIOR DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS AND WORKING WITH THE ARCHITECT AND ADVISORY SERVICES TO YOU PEOPLE AND WRITING UP OF THE SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE MOVABLE EQUIPMENT SO THAT YOU COULD PROCEED TO PURSUE FURNISHINGS. THERE ARE 5 IN OUR FIRM. THERE IS AN ADVANTAGE TO HAVING A SMALL FIRM OF CONSULTANTS; THE PROJECTS ARE CLOSER TO YOU. THE INITIAL PHASE WOULD TAKE 6 WEEKS OR 2 MONTHS WOULD BE MORE LIKE IT. WE WOULD COME UP WITH SCHEMATICS AND THEN HAVE ANOTHER MEETING WITH YOU, POSSIBLY MORE INFORMAL.

MINUTES OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING - OCTOBER 27, 1967

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DECATUR PUBLIC LIBRARY WAS HELD ON OCTOBER 27, 1967 IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE MAIN LIBRARY.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 4:40 P.M. BY MR. OLSEN.

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR BOARD MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 15, 1967 WERE APPROVED.

MR. DUMAS ANNOUNCED A WORKSHOP TO STUDY LIBRARY LAWS IS TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 8, 1967 BY THE ROLLING PRAIRIE LIBRARY SYSTEM, AND ASKED THE BOARD MEMBERS TO LET HIM KNOW IF THEY PLAN TO ATTEND.

IN SUMMARIZING THE STATISTICAL REPORT, MR. DUMAS STATED THAT CIRCULATION IS DOWN 1800 FOR THIS MONTH, THE FIRST TIME IT HAS DROPPED IN SEVERAL MONTHS. MR. DUMAS STATED THAT THE LIBRARY IS IN AN INTENSIVE WEEDING OUT PROGRAM, DISCARDING EVERYTHING THAT IS DATED OR HAS STOPPED CIRCULATING AND HAS NO SCHOLARLY VALUE. ANYTHING OF MARKETABLE VALUE IS SAVED.

MR. DUMAS REPORTED ON THE NORTH CENTRAL LIBRARY CONFERENCE HELD IN MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN OCTOBER 11-14, 1967. HE STATED THAT THE CONFERENCE WAS SURPRISINGLY GOOD AND THAT HE FOUND IT MOST STIMULATING. HOW LIBRARIES HAVE TO CHANGE IN THE NEXT 30 YEARS IN ORDER TO KEEP UP WITH THE TIMES WAS A POINT OF DISCUSSION. TEXT BOOKS OF PROGRAMMED INSTRUCTION ARE CURRENTLY VERY POPULAR AND SHOULD BE INVESTIGATED AS TO THE POSSIBILITY OF ADDITION TO THE COLLECTION. THE PERSONNEL SHORTAGE WAS DISCUSSED AND IT WAS ESTIMATED THAT UP TO 125,000 VACANCIES EXIST THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

CHAIRMAN OF THE PROPERTIES AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, MR. MILLER, MOVED THAT A TRANSFER OF \$400.00 BE MADE FROM CODE 402, CONTINGENCIES, TO CODE 215, SERVICES TO MAINTAIN AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT. THE MOTION CARRIED.

MR. MILLER GAVE AN INFORMATIONAL REPORT ON THE SUMMARY OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE MONTH AND BILLS APPROVED THROUGH SEPTEMBER 22, 1967. THE REPORT WAS UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED BY A ROLL-CALL VOTE.

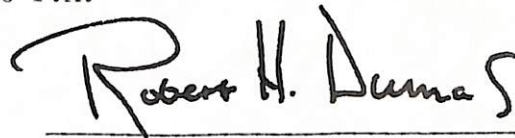

WITH RESPECT TO THE LIBRARY REMAINING OPEN ON CERTAIN HOLIDAYS, MR. SAPPINGTON REPORTED THAT THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION AND CITY ATTORNEY LANDHOLT HAD BEEN CONTACTED. THEY INDICATED THAT THERE ARE NO CIVIL SERVICE RESTRICTIONS CONCERNING HOLIDAYS TAKEN, AND THAT IT WOULD BE A MATTER OF POLICY TO BE DECIDED BY THE BOARD.

MR. SCHUERMAN STATED THAT A SPECIAL MEETING HAD BEEN HELD BY THE NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY BUILDING COMMITTEE WITH CONSULTANTS OF INTERIOR PLANNING AND DESIGN SERVICES OF NEW YORK CITY, AND THAT A PROPOSAL HAD BEEN RECEIVED FROM THIS FIRM, WHICH IS NOW BEING TAKEN UNDER ADVISEMENT BY THE COMMITTEE.

THE NEXT REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE BOARD IS SCHEDULED FOR FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 1967 AT 4:30 P.M. IN THE BOARD ROOM OF THE MAIN LIBRARY.

THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 5:30 P.M.
