## WHAT WAS PROHIBITION?

---

The ratification of the 18th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution in 1920 banned the manufacture, transportation and sale of intoxicating liquors and ushered in a period in American history known as Prohibition.

The result of a widespread temperance movement during the first decade of the 20th century, Prohibition was difficult to enforce.

The increase of the illegal production and sale of liquor ("bootlegging"), the proliferation of speakeasies (illegal drinking spots) and the rise in crime led to waning support for Prohibition by the end of the 1920s.

In 1933, Congress ratified a 21st Amendment to the Constitution that repealed the 18th, bringing the Prohibition era to a close.
