

Called Meeting of the Library Board
May 10, 1935

Present: Messrs. Shade, Allen, Borchers, Knuth, Mrs. Vincent

The meeting was held in the home of the senior member of the Board, Mr. W. P. Shade. The meeting was called for the purpose of hearing the sixtieth annual report for the year ending April 30, 1935.

The report for April was accepted unread as it is incorporated in the annual report. The reports of the president and librarian were both read and, on motion accepted and ordered placed on file. The president's report was signed by all members present and the librarian was to send the reports to the Mayor the next day, after being sworn to before a notary.

It was reported that the Buildings and Grounds committee had met to pass on T. A. Brinkoetter's specifications for remodeling the heating system. Mr. W. C. Field had called up to say that Mr. Brinkoetter's bid was all right, and that the work would be done under his supervision. The Buildings and Grounds ^{committee} was to submit heating specifications to the I.P.L. to have it checked up.

It was reported that Mr. Frazier, superintendent of parks, looked over the library grounds and made suggestions about planting shrubs, etc. He said the Park board will furnish shrubs needed but cannot furnish labor unless it is relief. Mr. Frazier asked for the old red brick left over from the stack building which the City had donated to the library. On motion, these were to be given to him.
