The Board of Directors of the Decatur Public Library sincerely regret the death of their fellow member, J. E. Osborne, which occurred April 18, 1930. Mr. Osborne's term of service was brief but useful. Appointed to the board in the Spring of 1919, he plunged into his duties with enthusiasm guided by good business sense. As a member of the building and grounds committee, he gave personal attention to the building needs and put through in a most satisfactory manner important work. His illness and death cut short what would have been a highly useful career.

His passing leaves a vacancy which will be hard to fill, but the board is glad that he had this opportunity for useful public service however brief, and that it had the pleasure of working with Mr. Osborne.
